**Re: Alico Road Widening from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to east of  
Airport Haul Road Begins**

Property owner:

The Lee County Department of Transportation (LC DOT) and its contractor, Tomahawk Construction, begin work in December to widen Alico Road to a four-lane roadway with shared use paths, improved drainage and new underground utilities from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Airport Haul Road. The project cost is \$18 million. The project is expected to be completed by late spring 2021.

The proposed interim 4-lane typical section includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, four-foot wide bicycle lanes, 12-foot-wide multi-use paths on the north and south sides of Alico Road. A wide median will accommodate future travel and/or transit lanes. The roadway will also include median landscaping that will be installed upon completion of the roadway construction.

The contractor will begin work on the north side of the right-of-way to build the new westbound lanes, then switch traffic to these new lanes to work on the new eastbound lanes on the south side of the right-of-way. After that the contractor will open one lane on each side to work in the median. No lane closures are allowed during government celebrated holidays, hurricanes or other catastrophic events.
